What's in this lesson?

"Baseball Season" (Video Link and PDF)

Follow along with this video read-aloud of a story about a boy and his baseball team.

Sounds Of A Baseball Game (PowerPoint)

A PowerPoint that includes large photographs of scenes from a baseball game accompanied by a short audio clip for each image. To view as a slide show, choose "Slide Show" \rightarrow "Play From Start" from the menu bar at the top of the page. Click on the speaker symbol to hear the audio clip on each page.

Exploring Field Positions (Google Slides Link)

An interactive activity that reviews different player positions on a baseball diamond. Click (or touch) each symbol to see video clips of players in each position.

O "Home Run" (PowerPoint)

A short story about Babe Ruth presented in a narrated PowerPoint format. To view as a slide show, choose "Slide Show" \rightarrow "Play From Start" from the menu bar at the top of the page.

"Who Is At The Baseball Game?" (PDF)

A short story that discusses the different people you might see at a baseball. A nice review of the vocabulary presented last week (e.g., pitcher, batter, etc.).
