
The team is ready to take the field. Who is that on the field?




Who is #1?

That was a good catch.




Who is #3?

That was a good tag.




Who is #4?

That was a good hit.




Who is #6?

That was a good run.




Who is #7?

Who is in black?


That is the umpire.
