Speech Group Activity Week of 7/13/20: Beach #2

What's in this lesson?

There are a variety of materials included here. Please feel free to try any or all of them, depending on what works best for your student and your family. You do not need to focus on all of these target areas. Whatever you do, have fun!

• Beach Fun Visuals (PDF)

Picture symbols of vocabulary words related to the Beach Fun story. Print/cut these out or take a screenshot on your device, then model the use of these words (e.g., by touching these picture symbols on the paper/screenshot or on your child's speech-generating device) during the activities.

• "Beach Fun" (video link and PDF)

Follow along with this video read-aloud of a story about fun things to do at the beach. We'll look at some of the objects you might use at the beach.

• Pack a Beach Bag (video link and PDF)

Print out (or take a screen shot) of your beach bag packing list, grab a bag, and then watch the video as I look for and then decide which items to pack in my beach bag.

• Comprehension-What to do at the beach (PDF)

As a follow-up to the "Beach Fun" story, some students might want to answer comprehension questions related to the story.

• **Beach Sort** (PDF)

As a follow up to the pack a beach bag activity, some students might enjoy sorting photos of objects into two bins or piles – things to bring to the beach (yes) and things not to bring to the beach (no).
