A welcoming environment greets each student, each day. Kennedy Day School provides special education services to students, ages 3 to 22, with complex, multiple challenges in the areas of communication, health, cognition, vision, hearing, physical/motor/mobility, sensory and social interaction.

With a longstanding inter-relationship of hospital and school, Kennedy Day School is uniquely designed to serve students with acute and chronic health care problems. These health concerns include seizure disorder, respiratory impairment (severe asthma, tracheostomy, and ventilator dependence), orthopedic, metabolic/nutritional, neurologic disorders and other congenital anomalies. Students benefit from specialized and integrative support strategies, equipment and resources to promote learning, communication and meaningful interaction within the community.

Kennedy Day School is dedicated to serving each student as an individual, with specifically tailored, comprehensive, and interdisciplinary strategies and services. With a full spectrum of integrative services, weekly clinical team meetings focus on planned collaboration to maximize positive, student-centered outcomes, addressed consistently across clinical areas and learning environments.
